1	Zonal Level Resource Persons' Training/ Workshops	A	4	35	1400	360	Zonal-Level Workshops: Under the Environment Education Programme (EEP), implemented in Assam by the Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) with support from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), Government of India, four Zonal-Level Workshops on innovative waste utilization were organized during January 2026. These workshops aimed to build the capacity of teachers as Resource Persons and promote practical, replicable approaches to sustainable waste management. A workshop on Upcycling Waste Cocoons into Decorative Items was held at Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya, Behali, on 19–20 January, with 40 teachers from 10 districts participating. Dr. Tarali Kalita, Cotton University, served as the Resource Person and conducted technical and hands-on sessions. A Resource Persons' Workshop on Upcycling Waste Paper into Reusable Paper was organized at Sipajhar College on 21–22 January, with 40 participants from nine districts. Participants were

						trained in paper shredding, soaking, pulping, pressing, and drying, along with the use of natural fibres and eco-friendly materials. A Resource Persons' Workshop on Making Utility Items from Water Hyacinth was held at Science College, Kokrajhar, on 8–9 January. Teachers from 10 districts of Lower Assam received practical training in converting the invasive aquatic weed into useful eco-friendly products. Sessions also highlighted the importance of solid waste management and waste-to-wealth practices. A Zonal-Level Workshop on Upcycling Used Paper into Eco-Friendly Pens was organized at Haflong Government College, bringing together participants from Cachar, Dima Hasao, Hailakandi, Hojai, and Sribhumi. The workshop promoted creative reuse, sustainable resource management, and practical waste reduction. The workshops combined technical inputs, demonstrations, interactive discussions, and hands-on learning, enabling participants to acquire practical skills that could be replicated in their respective districts and schools. Collectively, the programmes strengthened participants' capacity, encouraged innovation and circular-economy practices, and demonstrated the potential of waste materials to be transformed into useful and eco-friendly products.
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2	District Level Resource Persons' Trainings/ Workshops	A	34	34	1400	2000	District Level Workshops: Following the successful completion of the Zonal-Level Resource Persons' (RP) Workshops, the trained teachers conducted cascade-level training programmes for school teachers under the Environment Education Programme (EEP). The workshops focused on (i) Upcycling Waste Cocoons into Decorative Items, (ii) Making Utility Items from Water Hyacinth, (iii) Upcycling Waste Paper into Reusable Paper, and (iv) Upcycling Used Paper into Eco-Friendly Pens. These activities promoted creative reuse, sustainable resource management, waste-to-wealth practices, and circular economy principles. The training programmes were conducted across 34 districts of Assam, covering approximately 1,400 schools and 2,000 teachers. The trained teachers served as resource persons, sharing their knowledge and practical skills through demonstrations and hands-on sessions. The initiative expanded the reach of the zonal-level training, strengthened the capacity of teachers and Eco Clubs, and encouraged sustainable waste management and environmental conservation across Assam.



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3.	State-Level Workshop on Mushroom Cultivation	A	1	35	35	40	State-Level Workshop on Mushroom Cultivation: Tihu College, Tihu, organized a two-day State-Level Workshop on Mushroom Cultivation/Farming on 6–7 March 2026. The workshop was attended by college teachers representing 35 colleges across Assam and aimed to promote mushroom cultivation as a sustainable livelihood and income-generating opportunity. The workshop was convened by Mr. Dipanjan Dey, Coordinator, Mushroom Cultivation Unit, Tihu College, and presided over by Dr. Suresh Bharali, Principal, Tihu College. Dr. Bharali emphasized the potential of mushroom cultivation as a sustainable livelihood and encouraged participating colleges to establish mushroom cultivation units on their campuses. Prof. Jyotiraj Pathak, Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University, attended as the Guest of Honour and highlighted the growing relevance of mushroom cultivation, particularly its low investment requirements, short production cycle, and potential for good returns. Technical sessions were conducted by Ms. Namita Haloi Baishya, a mushroom entrepreneur from Mahina, Nalbari.



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4.	Workshops on Preparation of Eco-Friendly Holi Colours	A	44	35	44	2200	Workshops on Preparation of Eco-Friendly Holi Colours The Workshops on Preparation of Eco-Friendly Holi Colours were initiated to promote environmentally responsible celebration of festivals among students and teachers, encouraging Eco Clubs to serve as local ambassadors of sustainable festivities. A total of 44 workshops were conducted across Assam ahead of Holi, training more than 200 students in preparing natural colours using locally available materials such as corn flour, beetroot, raw turmeric, gram flour, carrot, spinach leaves, vine spinach seeds, marigold, and Flame of the Forest flowers. Through hands-on sessions, students learned techniques for preparing safe and eco-friendly colours as an alternative to synthetic colours. The trained students subsequently prepared natural colours through their Eco Clubs and celebrated eco-friendly Holi in their schools and communities. Several Eco Clubs also packaged and sold the colours locally, generating revenue while demonstrating the potential of sustainable products for school-level income generation. The initiative combined environmental awareness, experiential learning, entrepreneurship, and sustainable celebration, encouraging communities to adopt greener festival practices.



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5.	Eco Club Level Sustainable Lifestyle Workshops on Solid Waste Management, Vermicomposting and Rain Water Harvesting	A	551	15	551	35000	One-day hands-on workshops were conducted through Eco Clubs in 551 schools across 15 districts of Assam. The workshops focused on providing students with practical, experiential learning opportunities on Solid Waste Management, Vermicomposting and Rain Water Harvesting and promoting the adoption of sustainable practices at the school and community levels. Teachers who had received district-level training on the respective themes during the previous financial year served as resource persons and subsequently conducted the workshops in their respective schools, creating an effective cascading model of capacity building. The programme reached nearly 30,000 students and 5,000 teachers, thereby significantly strengthening environmental awareness and capacity within school communities. The workshops were conducted in Kokrajhar, Hojai, Lakhimpur, Majuli, Morigaon, Nagaon, Nalbari, Sivasagar, Sonitpur, South Salmara-Mankachar, Sribhumi, Tinsukia, Udalguri, West Karbi Anglong and Tamulpur districts. Overall, the initiative demonstrated the effectiveness of the Eco Club network in taking practical environmental education directly to schools and fostering a culture of responsible environmental stewardship among students and teachers.



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6.	Eco Club Level Sustainable Lifestyle Workshops on (i) Upcycling Waste Cocoons into Decorative Items, (ii) Making Utility Items from Water Hyacinth, (iii) Upcycling Waste Paper into Reusable Paper, and (iv) Upcycling Used Paper into Eco-Friendly Pens.	A	717	23	717	50000	Following the successful completion of the District-Level Workshops, teachers trained under the district-level Resource Person (RP) workshops conducted hands-on training programmes within their respective schools under the Environment Education Programme (EEP). The workshops focused on (i) Upcycling Waste Cocoons into Decorative Items, (ii) Making Utility Items from Water Hyacinth, (iii) Upcycling Waste Paper into Reusable Paper, and (iv) Upcycling Used Paper into Eco-Friendly Pens. The Eco Club-level workshops were conducted across 717 schools of Assam, with the participation of nearly 50,000 students and teachers. Teachers trained through the District-Level Workshops acted as facilitators and conducted practical demonstrations and hands-on sessions in their respective schools, enabling students to learn and apply sustainable waste management techniques using locally available waste materials. Outcome: Schools utilise their wet solid waste for composting, with the compost produced being used in their kitchen gardens. This practice promotes waste-to-resource management, supports sustainable food production, and helps transform school campuses into more sustainable and self-reliant green spaces.



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7.	District Level Eco-Hackathon cum Exhibition	A	34	34	1400	4500	The District Level Eco-Hackathon cum Exhibition provides a platform for school eco-club students to showcase their products, models, ideas, and projects. These innovations highlight the practical skills students have developed through hands-on sustainable lifestyle workshops, featuring initiatives like vermicomposting, solid waste management, upcycling waste cocoons into utility products, and recycling used paper. Objectives: • To provide a platform for students to showcase sustainable innovations developed through Eco Club. • To encourage creativity, innovation, and problem-solving among students by promoting practical, eco-friendly solutions based on sustainable lifestyle practices. • To inspire knowledge sharing and wider adoption of sustainable practices by facilitating interaction among students, teachers, experts, and the community, thereby strengthening environmental awareness and the objectives of the Environment Education Programme (EEP). Outcome: The Eco-Hackathon cum Exhibition encouraged students to transform their knowledge and skills into practical, innovative and sustainable solutions.



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8.	State Level Eco-Hackathon cum Exhibition	A	1	30	30	100	The State-Level Eco-Hackathon provided a vibrant platform for School Eco Club students to showcase innovative projects, models, products, and ideas focused on sustainability and environmental conservation. The exhibits demonstrated the students' practical learning and hands-on experiences in areas such as solid waste management, recycling, resource conservation, upcycling, and other eco-friendly innovations. The event encouraged students to think creatively, identify local environmental challenges, and develop practical solutions while fostering innovation, problem-solving, teamwork, and entrepreneurial thinking. Participants from 30 districts across the state took part in the event, bringing diverse ideas and innovative solutions that reflected the creativity and environmental consciousness of young learners. The Hackathon also facilitated peer learning and knowledge sharing, inspiring students and Eco Clubs to replicate successful practices in their schools and communities. Overall, the initiative strengthened the spirit of Mission LiFE by encouraging students to adopt and promote sustainable lifestyles through practical action.



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9.	Nature Camps	B	34	34	340	2000	Under the Environment Education Programme (EEP), a series of two-day, one-night Nature Camps were organised across various districts of Assam during February–March 2026, with support from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, and implementation support from ASTEC, Government of Assam. The camps aimed to promote environmental awareness, biodiversity conservation and experiential learning among school and college students. Objectives • To promote environmental awareness and biodiversity conservation among students. • To provide experiential, field-based learning opportunities beyond the classroom. • To sensitise students towards forest, wildlife and habitat conservation. • To encourage sustainable practices, responsible environmental behaviour and Mission LiFE. Activities carried out • Nature trails, trekking and forest walks. • Bird watching, butterfly observation and identification of flora and fauna. • Biodiversity documentation and field surveys. • Expert-led sessions on biodiversity, wildlife, forests, wetlands and conservation. • Group discussions, quizzes, poster-making, painting, photography and slogan-writing.



						• Nature-based games, cultural activities and reflection sessions. • Plantation drives and environmental action planning. • Sessions on waste management, vermicomposting and sustainable practices. Exposure Visit Areas: Poba Reserve Forest, Jonai; Bhoirab Hill Reserved Forest & Doloni Beel; Gaurisagar Tank; Maguri Beel & Dibru-Saikhowa National Park; Kakojana Reserve Forest; Manas National Park; Bogamati; Orang National Park & Tiger Reserve; Behali Wildlife Sanctuary & Behali Reserve Forest; Dihira Reserve Forest; Lumding Reserve Forest; Rain Forest Research Institute (RFRI), Jorhat; Pani Dihing Bird Sanctuary; Bhuban Nagar Forest, Cachar; Padumoni Forest and Umrangso, West Karbi Anglong; Aynakhal Forest, Hailakandi; Panbari Forest, South Salmara-Mankachar. Overall Outcome The Nature Camp Programme provided students with meaningful learning-by-doing experiences beyond the classroom, enhancing their understanding of biodiversity, ecosystems and environmental conservation. Direct exposure to natural habitats, interaction with experts and participation in practical activities fostered greater environmental consciousness, appreciation for Assam's biodiversity, teamwork, responsible behaviour and a stronger connection with nature, while encouraging students to adopt sustainable practices and contribute to conservation efforts.

1.	World Environment Day 2025	05-06-2025	The WED 2025 was celebrated across the state with wide participation from Eco Clubs and communities. The event focused on plastic pollution and sustainable practices. State Level Activities conducted: Radio Jingles aired on GUP SHUP 94.3 FM across 3 cities of Assam (Dhubri, Haflong and Guwahati) for conveying the messages on environmental conservation and plastic pollution to a wider audience. Art Competition, engaging young minds to express their environmental concerns and visions through creativity. Students in large number participated in the competition. Plantation Drive, led by the Hon'ble Minister, Science and Technology Department, Government of Assam, reaffirming the commitment to a greener future. Popular Talk, delivered by Dr. Binoy Kr. Saikia, Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Award recipient for Science and Technology and Principal Scientist at the North East Institute of Science and Technology, Jorhat (NEIST) inspired children, youth, and stakeholders towards adopting science and technology for solving modern problems and addressing climate action. Best Eco Club Awards presented to three outstanding school Eco Clubs and one college Eco Club for their exemplary efforts in environmental education and action. The recipient schools/colleges are: 1. Mangaldai College District & Eco Club Level Activities conducted: The district level activities were conducted through hundreds of Eco Clubs across the state with support from the District Nodal Agencies. Earth Day and International Day for Biological Diversity	22-04-2025 and 22-05-2025	Earth Day (April 22) and the International Day for Biological Diversity (May 22) are two major environmentally significant days actively celebrated by Eco Clubs across the state. These observances serve as important platforms to educate students about critical environmental issues such as climate change, biodiversity loss, deforestation, and pollution. Activities conducted: Thousands of schools and colleges across Assam actively participated in statewide campaigns to mark environmentally significant days. These celebrations, led by Eco Clubs under the Environment Education Programme (EEP), aimed to raise awareness about pressing environmental issues and promote conservation values among students. A wide range of activities were organized, including poster-making competitions, mass awareness rallies, plantation drives, documentary screenings, debates, and interactive sessions on biodiversity and climate action. These engaging initiatives provided young learners with hands-on experiences and inspired them to adopt sustainable practices in their daily lives. The overwhelming participation reflected a growing sense of environmental responsibility among Assam's youth.
3.	International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer- 2025	16-09-2025	The Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) observed the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer 2025 (Ozone Day) on 16th September 2025 with a series of activities organised across the state. The celebrations were carried out with the active support and collaboration of its wide network of partners under the Environment Education Programme (EEP). The programme aimed at creating awareness on the importance of protecting the ozone layer and highlighting global, national, and local efforts undertaken under the Vienna Convention and the Montreal Protocol. To achieve this, a diverse range of activities were held at multiple levels, such as schools/ colleges, district platforms, and state-level programme State Level Activities: 1-day event was organised at Bigyan Bhawan, Guwahati, to celebrate the state-level function of Ozone Day 2025. Sri Pallav Gopal Jha, IAS, Secretary to the Science & Technology Department, Govt. of Assam. The key activities of the event are as follows: Poster making competition: The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from members of Eco Clubs, who used the platform to showcase their artistic talent and scientific understanding of the day's theme. Scientific talk and interaction session: Delivered by Dr. Bipul Chandra Sarma, Associate Professor, Department of Chemical Sciences, Tezpur University. In his insightful talk, Dr. Sarma explained in simple and engaging terms the chemistry behind ozone depletion, detailing how man-made chemicals such as chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), halons, and other ozone-depleting substances (ODSs) break down ozone molecules in the stratosphere, thereby thinning the protective layer.



			District Level Activities: The school and college Eco Clubs established under the Environment Education Programme (EEP) served as one of the strongest pillars of the Ozone Day 2025 celebrations across Assam. With the active guidance of teachers, the clubs organised a wide variety of activities that not only spread awareness but also encouraged hands-on participation and experiential learning among students. The activities included plantation drives to symbolise the role of green cover in maintaining ecological balance, poster and art competitions to encourage creative expression, debate competitions to sharpen critical thinking on environmental issues, and poster exhibitions that carried powerful messages on the need to protect the ozone layer. Many clubs also conducted awareness sessions on ozone-depleting substances (ODSs), their impact on the environment and health, and India's proactive measures such as the India Cooling Action Plan (ICAP) and its alignment with the Kigali Amendment. In addition to on-ground events, a special webinar series was organised to complement the celebrations and provide a platform for dialogue across institutions. Outreach: An information leaflet was published in connection with World Ozone Day 2025. The leaflet emphasizes the importance of safeguarding the ozone layer through global cooperation and scientific action, showcasing India's commitment to phasing out ozone-depleting substances and promoting sustainable cooling practices under the India Cooling Action Plan (ICAP). Moreover, a specially designed radio jingle was broadcast on FM radio at multiple time slots, reaching out to a wide audience across different age groups. The jingle carried simple yet powerful messages on the importance of protecting the ozone layer, encouraging people to adopt ozone-friendly practices in their daily lives. This medium proved effective in spreading awareness beyond schools and institutions, ensuring that the message of Ozone Day reached households and communities at large.
4.	Green Diwali	On the eve of Deepavali, 2025	These activities were organised across several school Eco Clubs and witnessed enthusiastic participation from thousands of students. Awareness Programme: Awareness sessions were conducted to sensitise students about the environmental implications of certain modern Diwali practices. During the session, students were informed about how excessive use of firecrackers contributes to air and noise pollution, while plastic-based decorations often lead to increased waste generation. Hands-on Activity: Students participated in a creative hands-on activity focused on decorating and upcycling clay diyas. Students used colours, brushes and creative designs to decorate traditional earthen lamps. In many Eco Clubs, the activity also included upcycling previously used diyas, where students repainted and redesigned them to give them a new and attractive appearance.

Public Outreach on Environment Education Programme	07-11-2025 to 09-05-2025	An exhibition stall showcasing initiatives on Environment Education Programme (EEP) and science outreach was set up by the Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) during the 5th State Level Conclave of Ellora Vigyan Mancha, Assam, held from 7–9 November 2026. The stall aimed to create awareness among participants and visitors about environmental conservation, sustainable lifestyles, and science-based initiatives being implemented in the state under Environment Education Programme. Key attractions: The stall prominently displayed information about the Environment Education Programme (EEP) being implemented by ASTEC under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India. Posters and display panels explained the objectives and activities of the programme, particularly its implementation through Eco Clubs in schools and colleges across Assam to promote environmental awareness, biodiversity conservation, and sustainable living practices among students. A Sustainable Kit was also displayed at the stall to demonstrate simple steps individuals can adopt to reduce waste and promote a zero-waste lifestyle. The kit included reusable items such as a steel glass for water and tea, spoon, fork, knife, a reusable water bottle, and a cloth bag. Visitors were informed about how using such everyday reusable items can significantly reduce single-use plastic and waste generation. The exhibition attracted visitors from various backgrounds and age groups who showed keen interest in the displays and interacted with the representatives to learn more about the initiatives. The District Commissioner of Kamrup District also visited the stall and appreciated the efforts being undertaken to promote environmental awareness and sustainable living practices.
2.	Summer Camp at Kaziranga National Park	10-07-2025 to 12-07-2025	A three-day nature conservation and awareness camp was held at Kaziranga National Park from 10–12 July 2025, bringing together experts, students, and community members to promote youth engagement in sustainability through learning, dialogue, and field experiences. Organized under the long-running Nature Orientation Initiative, the event was a collaborative initiative between Kaziranga National Park, the EEP Cell of ASTEC, contributions from organizations like WWF-India, WTI, etc. Participants took part in field-based activities such as forest visits, wildlife discussions, and conservation exercises, alongside sessions on health, environmental stewardship, and youth career mentoring. Activities like yoga, sports, and interactive games promoted overall well-being, and a surprise visit from the cast of “Rudra” helped connect conservation with popular culture.
